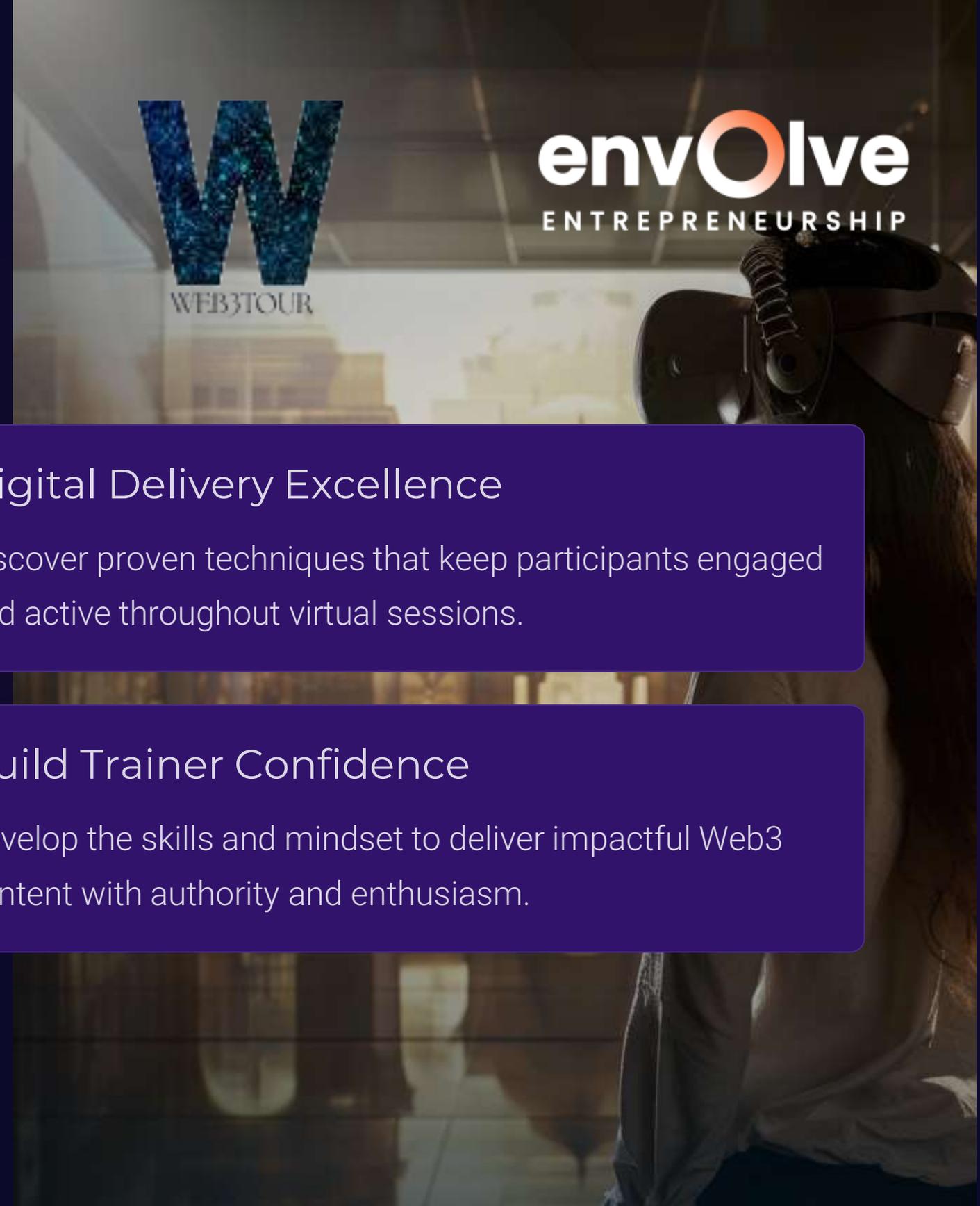

Digital Delivery – Best Practices

The 10-Minute Rule

Switch delivery methods every 10 minutes to maintain attention. Mix presentations, discussions, polls, and breakouts for optimal engagement.

Strategic Breakout Rooms

Provide crystal-clear instructions and specific outcomes. Assign roles, set timers, and always debrief with the full group.

Camera Culture

Require cameras on during interactive segments. Model energy and enthusiasm – your presence sets the tone for participation.

Interactive Technology

Leverage polls, Miro boards, and Mentimeter to keep energy high. Use real-time feedback to adjust your delivery dynamically.

Extended Support

Offer 'office hours' post-workshop for deeper questions. This builds trust and demonstrates commitment to learner success.

Trainer Tips by Module



Module 1: Opportunities

Use real-world analogies i.e. Arkive, British Museum NFTs etc. Make abstract concepts tangible and relatable.



Module 2: Risk Management

Present risk scenarios and ask "How would you respond?" Let participants problem-solve collaboratively.



Module 3: Case Studies

Let participants reverse-engineer successful cases. Guide them to discover key success factors independently.



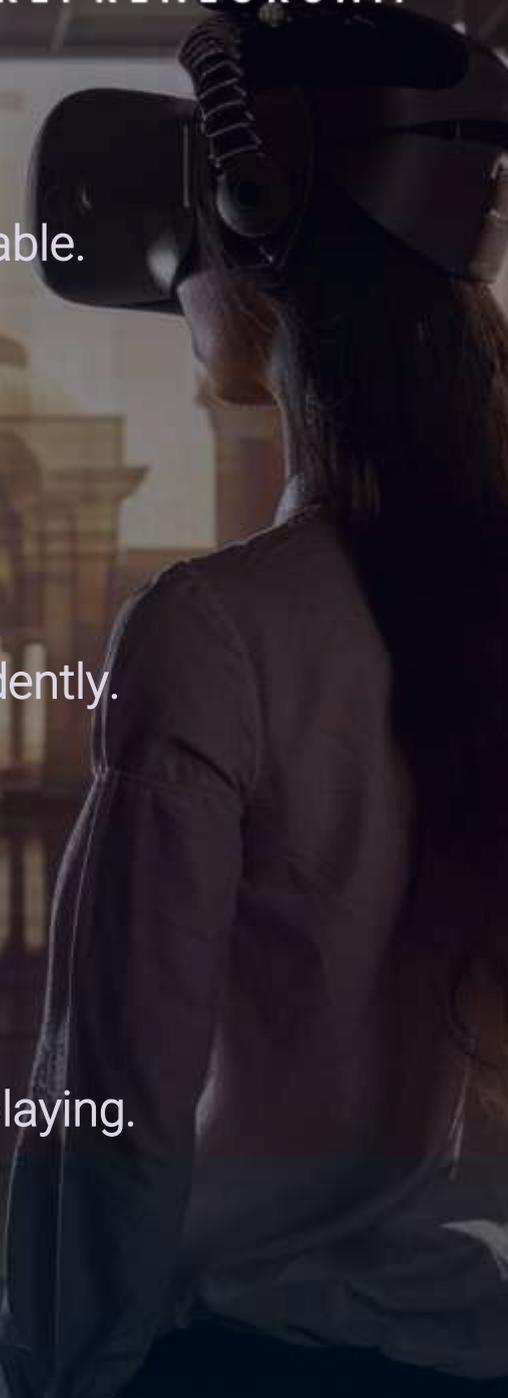
Module 4: Trends

Co-create trend adoption roadmaps. Make participants active contributors to the learning experience.



Module 5: Development

Practice explaining Web3 concepts to different audience types. Build communication skills through role-playing.



Engaging Your Participants



Multi-Tool Engagement

Combine polls, chat, and fast-paced breakout groups. Vary your tools to match different learning preferences and energy levels.

Flip the Classroom

Start sessions with a challenge or problem. Let curiosity drive learning rather than beginning with theory.

Peer Learning Power

Create expert circles where participants teach each other. Harness collective knowledge and build confidence.

Digital Body Language

Watch for participation patterns, chat engagement, and camera positioning. Adjust energy and pace based on visual cues.



 **Pro Tip:** Create psychological safety first – participants engage more when they feel comfortable making mistakes and asking questions.

Evaluation & Wrap-Up

Application Focus

Ask: "What Web3 concept will you apply first?"
This creates commitment and bridges learning to action.

Feedback Collection

Gather insights via forms or chat. Use feedback to continuously improve your delivery and content.
